We work with these organizations in identifying, promoting, and developing relationships with small and diverse companies. The percentage of business dollars spent with small and diverse businesses is impacted by the nature of the pharmaceutical distribution industry, where a majority of spend is with major pharmaceutical manufacturers where alternative procurement options may not exist. To improve penetration, AmerisourceBergen has partnered with the Inner City Capital Connections (ICCC) to provide education, development and access to capital for interested innovative diverse suppliers.
